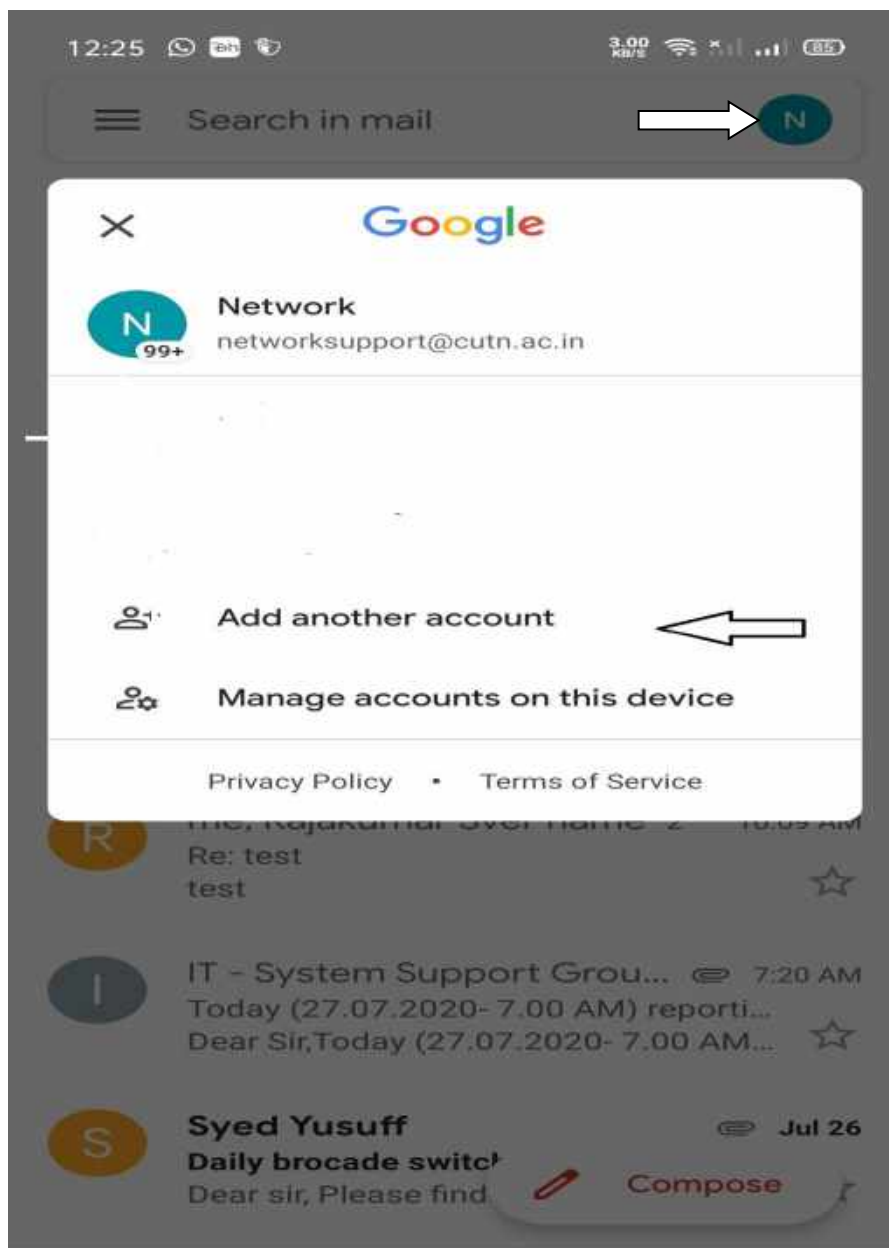


HOW TO ADD AND CONFIGURE CUTN MAIL ID IN GMAIL APPLICATION

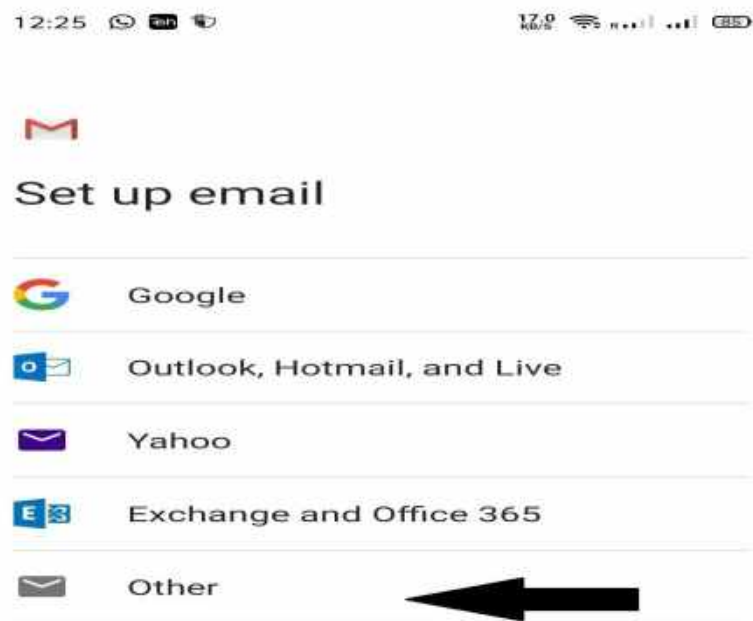
1. Open Gmail application in your mobile, After check on your email id already add same ID in old cutn account click **Manage account on this device** the remove your old one.

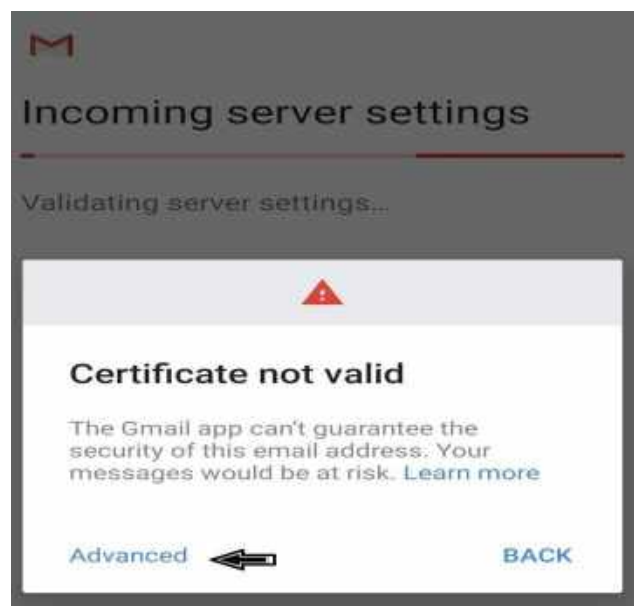

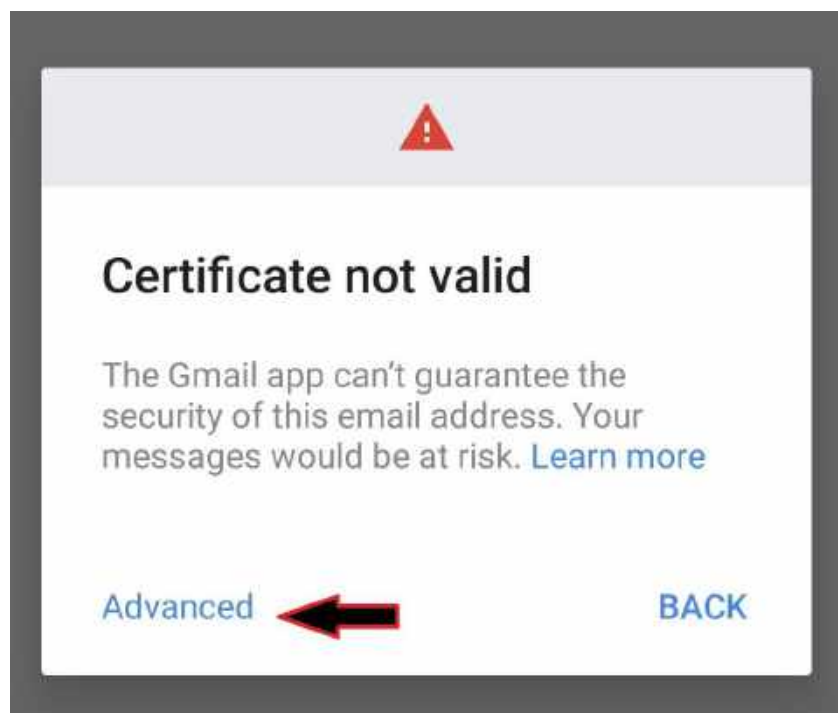

11. Same steps are outgoing mail server. Click Advance option.



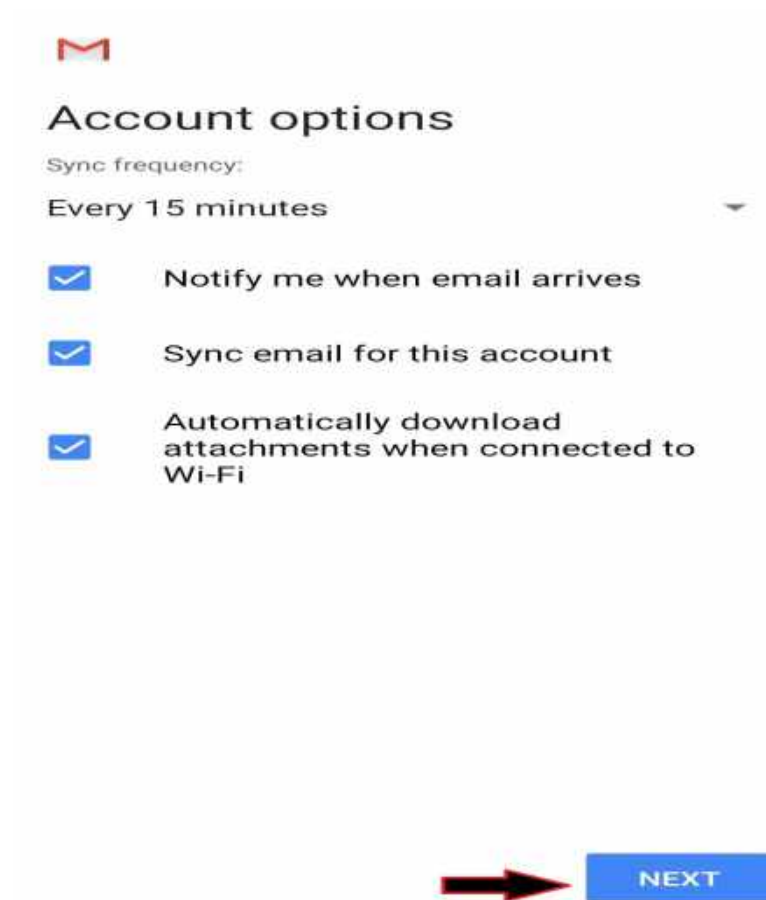
12. Certificate information scroll down the page after click **PROCESS ANYWAY** option.
